



EXTREME STEAM SCIENCE KIDS ROBOTIC PROGRAM FOR CODE & GO

The Extreme Steam Science Kids Code and Go Robotics Program has been created for pre-kindergarten through 1st grade boys and girls. The 8 week camp schedule has been strategically put together, so that multiple sessions can be organized. We recommend a minimum of 2 weeks for a session that takes place 5 days per week for a total of 10 days. A 2 week session must incorporate weeks 1 and 2 comprised of lessons 1 – 6. This session can be repeated each 2 weeks of camp with new boys and girls. A 4 week session can be created incorporating weeks 1 – 4 comprised of lessons 1 – 9 and 14 & 15. This can be repeated twice during the summer with new boys and girls for each session. You can run a 6 and or an 8 week session incorporating the lessons found on the 8 week schedule. When running an 8 week session week 8 is used as a review for any lessons that the boys and girls might need extra help with.

Remember that weeks 1 & 2 set the stage for how the mouse robot is programmed. A strong foundation in this programming will give the boys and girls a better chance for success throughout their Extreme Steam Science Kids experience.

The different sessions are mentioned because you will have parents enrolling for a variety of sessions. It helps to be flexible with your offerings, so you do not turn anyone away. If a child begins with a 2 week program and wants to extend you can place them in a 4 week session or create one with any **SCHEDULING** other campers who might want to extend as well. The same concept can be applied with the 4 week session. Campers might begin with your 4 week session and want to extend for another 2 or 4 weeks.

This program can be part of your camp schedule and every pre-kindergarten camper through 1st grade camper would get this program with no extra charge involved. It can also be organized as a before camp, during camp or after camp program with an extra tuition. The business and marketing suggestions are part of this package which will help you when you organize this program.

It is strongly suggested for day camps to organize a parent visitation after weeks 2, 4, 6 and 8. In this way you can incentivize your parents who in turn can tell their friends. Spreading the word never hurt when selling what you do at your camp.
